What should I bring?

If you have reserved **deluxe** or **semi-deluxe** accommodations, linens and towels will be provided for you. If you are in any other accommodation, you will need to bring your own (e.g., Robins Nest, Eagles Perch, dorm-style cabin, etc.); you will want to bring:

- Towels
- Sleeping bags
- Pillows

Clothing: Hartland Christian Camp is located in the Sequoia National Forest and enjoys an elevation of about 4200 feet, with temperatures varying greatly. Fall afternoons are generally in the low 60s to mid 70s) and nights are cool to cold, with temperatures from the 60s down to the 30s at times. Bring:

- Warm clothing for the evenings
- Cooler clothing for the daytime

There are many trails around Hartland, so you might want to bring:

- Good walking/hiking shoes

Other great things to bring to camp:

- Bible
- Writing materials
- Camera
- Flashlight
- Spending money for the Coffee/Gift Shop.

Please remember: Hartland is fairly isolated, and there are no gasoline stations nearby.

- If you are coming through Visalia, Lemon Cove is the last place to buy gas.
- If you are coming from the North, the last place will be in Fresno.
